Personal Data Protection

1. Data Controller

2. What Personal Data We Process and for What Purpose

a) Grant Applicants

We process personal data provided in grant applications, in particular:

- first and last name
- contact details
- date of birth
- address
- information about professional activity
- project-related information
- ID document number (required only if support is granted)
- bank account number (required only if support is granted)

The purposes of processing are:

- evaluation of the application
- conclusion and performance of the contract
- payment of the foundation grant
- fulfilment of legal obligations (in particular accounting obligations)

The legal basis for processing is that processing is necessary for the performance of a contract or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract (Article 6(1)(b) GDPR), and compliance with legal obligations (Article 6(1)(c) GDPR).



b) Newsletter

If you subscribe to our newsletter, we process your email address for the purpose of sending information about the Foundation's activities. The legal basis is your consent, which you may withdraw at any time.

c) Website Visitors

When visiting the website, technical data (such as IP address or cookies) may be processed to ensure the functionality and security of the website.

3. Who May Access the Data

Personal data is accessible only to authorized persons within the Foundation.

The Foundation may use external service providers acting as data processors (e.g., for email and cloud storage services, electronic contract signing tools, and newsletter distribution).

These service providers process personal data solely on the basis of a data processing agreement with the Foundation and in compliance with applicable data protection legislation.

4. Data Retention Period

- Rejected applications are retained for 3 years.
- Data relating to supported projects and contractual documentation are retained for 10 years in accordance with legal requirements.
- Newsletter subscription data is retained until consent is withdrawn.

After the retention period expires, personal data is deleted or anonymized.

5. Your Rights

You have the right to:

- request access to your personal data
- request correction of inaccurate data
- request deletion or restriction of processing where legally applicable
- withdraw consent to receiving the newsletter
- lodge a complaint with the Czech Data Protection Authority (Úřad pro ochranu osobních údajů)

Applicants should not include sensitive personal data (e.g., information concerning health) in their application unless it is necessary for the evaluation of the application.
